National bestselling author Adam Shoalts will join us to discuss his well-known expeditions in Canada's wilderness, including crossing nearly 4,000 km of Canada's Arctic alone and more recently his canoe journey from Lake Erie to the Arctic.

His expeditions range from mapping rivers to archaelogical projects, however Shoalts is best known for his long solo journeys. Named one the "greatest living explorers" by CBC and even declared "Canada's Indiana Jones" by the *Toronto Star*, Shoalt's latest adventure is the subject of his new national best selling book Where the Falcon Flies.
